

SNOW & ICE REMOVAL ON SIDEWALKS

Ice and snow on sidewalks must be removed within 24 hours from when the snow/sleet stops (s/s 190-5). As temperatures rise in the day and get colder at night, snow and ice will freeze and thaw several times over a few days. You are responsible to make your best efforts to ensure that it is maintained in order to help eliminate risk to anyone walking there and to minimize the chance of someone falling. This entails checking the sidewalk regularly until all ice and snow is gone; salting and shoveling as needed and the sooner it is removed the better.

If you live at a corner it is your responsibility to do your best to keep the entire sidewalk safe and clear for school children or those walking about and needing to safely cross the street. If you can't use it safely then no one else can either. Snow is not permitted to be thrown into the street or onto neighboring properties.

Landlords, if it snows, the side-walks need to be shoveled within the same timeline as owner occupied properties; if it snows at your house then it probably snowed in Manheim. It is recommended you appoint someone in the building or pay a willing participant if you can't do it yourself.

Remember, sidewalks must be maintained free of snow and ice.

Failure to maintain sidewalks as noted shall constitute a ticket with every reoccurring notice issued throughout this year after the initial notification as provided below.

Fines are payable within 15 calendar days, unless approved by the Codes Official. Failure to pay said fee will result in the Borough instituting the appropriate legal action against the Offender to recover both the service fee(s) and any related administrative fee(s).

Payment may be made at the Borough Office Monday thru Thursday between 8:30 am thru 4:00 pm; Friday between 8:30 am thru 1:00 pm; by mail sent to the above address, or you may drop payment into the drop box located outside the Borough building at your convenience. Checks shall be made payable to "Manheim Borough".

An appeal from any decision of the Code Official may be taken to Borough Council. Such appeal shall be in writing, shall be verified by an affidavit, shall state the grounds therefore, and shall be filed with the Borough Secretary within 10 working days after such decision has been made. The appeal shall be accompanied by the current appeal fee of \$500.00; all fees shall be applied to costs related to the requested hearing.
